Writing Task 1 ^① depicts

The line graph depicts the number of noise complaints made to Environmental Health authorities, according to different sources of noise in Newtown, between the year of 1980 to 1996. Generally speaking, there was a dramatic increase of noise from domestic or household while road works noise decreased a lot throughout the years. a ~~slight~~ gradual decrease of noise from road works

In 1980, road construction projects were the major reason to be blamed for noise in the city. There were approximately 650 complaints made due to road works. Among all sources of noise, merely around 300 cases roughly were due to traffic. From 1985 to 1987, road works, traffic and domestic noise all faced a decline in complaint cases. During the same period, noise from factories encountered a slight increase from 600 to 700. Since then, the number of complaints had remained the same at 700 till 1996.

For road construction, noise complaint cases steadily decreased since 1990. By contrast, traffic and household noise complaint cases increased two-folds during the period from 1980 to 1996.
